C-String Concatenation Function

THE C-STRING CONCATENATION FUNCTION

- char* strcat(char* s1, const char* s2);
- Concatenates s2 at the end of s1, returns s1
 - s I must be large enough to hold the contents of s I and s2
 - sI may or many not be empty, but it must be null-terminated
 - The old null-termination character is overridden
